

Mastering RFIs and Submittals:

In a lot of projects, getting everyone on the same page and sorting out who's in charge of what can be a bit tricky. You've certainly experienced delays in sharing info and bits of the project getting lost in the shuffle. It's like a never-ending loop – the more unclear things are, the more questions pop up, which means more meetings, and before you know it, the project is dragging its feet.

Making matters even more problematic is that different teams have different workflow processes and software. It's like trying to dance to different beats – they rarely sync up seamlessly.

Before, a contractor would need clarity from an architect (ex: an RFI), they would normally have to prepare their question, send it through email (often through an intermediary like a project manager), and wait for the architect's answer before completing the task at hand.

It isn't just about the chance that these important emails might get lost in the chaos, buried under a pile of other urgent stuff. It also meant delays in the project, and you know how that can mess with the bottom line

The risk of error in document workflows increased even more as the many stakeholder groups were often times working in different platforms that didn't talk to each other.



While in the field, you can attach pictures to an RFI or Submittal by simply snapping a picture on your phone and adding it to the communication.


Imagine how much time you could save if you had the power to log as you go? The otherwise lost hours travelling between the job site and the office are now reincorporated in your workflow.






